The caudate lobe is a (physiologically) independent part of the liver, supplied by the right and left hepatic artery and portal vein. Blood from the caudate lobe drains directly into the vena cava.

Hepatic Caudate Resection | Abdominal Key

The caudate lobe is surrounded by major vascular structures, which can make resection technically challenging. The posterior and superior borders are formed by the retrohepatic IVC and the confluence of the left and middle hepatic veins, respectively, while the left portal vein and hepatic hilum serve as the anterior border.

One more uncommon resection is called a "caudate" resection - this means removing a single section called the caudate, which is part of the liver but is a separate lobe and is located in a position which makes removing it somewhat more involved.

The caudate lobe is considered to be a separate and distinct liver lobe with its own vascularization and biliary drainage. It is generally divided into 3 portions: the left Spiegel lobe (Couinaud's segment 1), the process portion, and the paracaval portion (Couinaud's segment 9). 1-3 The caudate lobe is an autonomous segment of the liver and Isolated caudate lobe resection: technical challenges Isolated caudate lobe resection is an alternative to these major resections. Isolated caudate lobectomy was first described by Lerut et al in 1990 . Caudate lobe resection is one of the most demanding procedures among hepatic resection, owing to its deep and complex location and its proximity to major vessels.

The caudate lobe is named after the tail-shaped hepatic tissue (cauda; Latin, "tail") caudate process of the liver, which provides surface continuity between the caudate lobe and the visceral surface of the right lobe of the liver.

The caudate lobe is anatomically different from other lobes in that it often has direct connections to the IVC through hepatic veins, that are separate from the main hepatic veins. The caudate lobe may be supplied by both right and left branches of the portal vein.

Special care must be taken regarding the caudate lobe's close proximity to the middle hepatic vein, retrohepatic caval attachments, and left-hepatic arterial supply. As a result of these factors, modern caudate lobectomy has only recently been initially described [10].

Caudate resection for primary and metastatic liver tumors ...

Results: In a total of 60 hepatectomies, 12 patients underwent caudate lobe resection (20%). This was either isolated resection of segment 1 (n = 3) or combined with right, left, extended left hepatectomy or atypical resections in one, three, one, and four instances, respectively.

The caudate lobe (1) has hepatic veins that often drain directly into the IVC. The portal vein divides the liver into upper (2, 4a, 8, 7) and lower (3, 4b, 5, 6) segments, and can usually be identified
